Dear Don,

Mighty Mac recently completed a project in Cabo San Lucas, Mexico, in which we diverted 4,000 GPD of wastewater from 127 condominiums and treated it onsite for irrigation purposes.

We used your PL-625 effluent filter on a secondary pre-treatment tank, thus preventing a major portion of solids from entering into the aeration chambers. We found the final discharge to be of superior quality and have had no clogging problems with our irrigation pumps.

In addition, we installed another PL-625 as a filter for their commercial laundry, consisting of seven washing machines. After six months, we again find no clogging issues from lint.

A third PL-625 was installed for the pool snack bar kitchen. It is doing an excellent job trapping the grease from the kitchen, which is frying French fries, tortilla chips, etc., in large volumes. The kitchen line feeds into a pump tank. Again, your filter is working fine in protecting our pump and plumbing from grease accumulation.

It was fortunate that we were able to test your filter in three applications on one job, and have such a positive outcome. I would recommend your PL-625 without hesitation,
